

King's Kids Week Crew [4-8 July 2022]

IMPORTANT

- 1) **Are you a Jesus follower / Born-again Christian?** To be part of the crew, you need to be a follower of Jesus. Which means you don't just say you're a Christian, you live like a Christian! You love Jesus. You spend time with Him, etc.
- 2) **Are you willing to work hard?** The KKW Crew works hard! Rewarding work, but hard work. Do you agree that you will not be lazy and you will give your everything?
- 3) **Are you available all the KKW days?**: That is 4-8 July every day 7:30 to 14:00.
- 4) **Are you available these other days?** You MUST be available these dates:
 1. Saturday 4 June. 5pm – 9pm. This is our first training session
 2. Saturday 2 July. 5pm – 9pm. This is our second training session and prep day.
 3. Sunday 3 July. 10am. Join our church service so we can pray for the team
 4. Sunday 3 July 1pm – 7pm That afternoon we'll get the hall ready.
 5. Thursday 7 July. 5pm-8pm. Worship evening for the crew.
 6. Friday evening. 8 July. 4:00pm – ±21:00. KKW Final + milkshakes afterwards
- 5) **Are you willing to buy the hoodie?** We have team hoodies that you have to buy. You can reuse if you already have one. This year if you buy: we'll give you 50% discount. Contact me if you can't afford it so we can help. (Price still to be announced)
- 6) **Are you prepared to come for an interview?** We might (on reading your application) want to interview you before accepting you into the crew.
- 7) **Will you get fingerprint clearance and give us a copy?** If you are 16 or above and want to work with children you HAVE TO get fingerprint clearance. Apply at police station. It costs R75 and takes about a month. To apply for KKW you must have already applied for fingerprint clearance and give it to us as soon as you get it.

Other things to know:

- 1) **There will be some extra events** There will be some voluntary activities some afternoons or evenings (like e.g. braai, photo challenge, etc.) This is just for the crew.
- 2) **Lunch will provided for you.** Lunch will be provided for you for free.
